The chapter adviser will email office@kon.org with each application. Please allow up to two weeks for review and consideration. These scholarship applications are reviewed as they are received and are approved or denied up to 100 awards each year. Each chapter may have scholarships awarded for a number up to half the previous year's reported initiates. (If chapter Alpha Beta had 20 initiates last year, they may have up to 10 students awarded financial aid in a given year under this scholarship).
